NISSAN TSBs (TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETINS)

Recommended Repairs for Your Nissan

Technical Service Bulletins (TSBs) are recommended steps and procedures for repairing vehicles. A TSB is issued by Nissan when there is a growing trend with an unanticipated problems, but does not warrant a recall. "Click and Clack" of NPR *Car Talk* fame, describe TSBs as really "just containing advice from the company to the mechanics who fix [the] cars". Most repair shops can lookup TSB information to get the recommended repairs from the manufacturer.
